Building your skill: Gymnastics Australia offer additional accreditation for high levels of session. We are able to assist in the completion of Intermediate and Advanced coaching courses.

The Role

You will adapt lesson plans and coach a variety of gymnastics programs in a safe, positive and fun environment for participants. You will require a Gymnastics Australia Fundamental/Intermediate and/or Advanced Coaching accreditation. Deliver a high quality, safe, gymnastics class which sees the children progressing through levels and learning about gymnastics in a positive manner.

Reliably arrive 5 mins before class start time to log in, set up and receive any memos or notifications from front desk.

Provide support and information to children and parents where you can or advise where to get information and the support that they need.

There are also opportunities to expand into other areas of the centre such as Customer Service and Play club or Sports programs.

What is the process of becoming a Gymnastics Australia Coach?

Your coaching journey starts with the Gymnastics Australia Fundamental Gymnastics Coaching course. This is the entry level pathway that allows new coaches to obtain a nationally recognized accreditation through a comprehensive on-the-job training program.

Your club will assign you a Club Coach Educator (CCE) to guide and support you through the on-the-job learning and completion of your Activity Pack. There is a minimum of 20 hours in the gym that needs to be completed. These 20 hours include shadowing sessions, learning about equipment safety, group organisation, activating lesson plans and behavioural management.

The Fundamental Gymnastics Coach Accreditation is self-paced, so you can feel supported in achieving your coaching goals. From recent coaches working their way through the course coaches have completed their activity pack and 20 hours in under 3 months.

After completing your Activity Pack, upload it online, Gymnastics Australia will review and confirm your CCE has signed you off as ready to start coaching independently.

You can then book into your Virtual Induction session. This online session only takes an hour, and there will be other coaches online with you. During this session, an experienced and friendly mentor will talk with you about coaching independently in your club.

Once you have attended this session, you will receive your official accreditation and be qualified to coach independently!

How much does it cost?

The Fundamental Gymnastic Coach course costs **\$250.00**. This price includes your online training, access to resources and 12 months of technical membership with Gymnastics Australia and your State/Territory Association.
